A significantly higher proportion of people than average live below the poverty line in South-West Belfast. South-West Belfast foodbank (serving from the Colin Neighbourhood and Dunmurry village to Andersonstown) gives hope and practical help to people in crisis, helping them towards a brighter future. Food Donations

All of our food is generously donated by people in the local community (at supermarkets, schools, businesses, churches, etc.) and volunteers of all backgrounds help to sort, pack, and distribute food parcels to individuals and families in need. Local people are feeding local people.

Frontline Care Professionals

The families and individuals who come to us have been referred by care professionals as needing short-term crisis food support. Social workers, health visitors, and many others, work with us to help people in crisis so that they do not have to go hungry.

Financial Support

We also need financial support to both meet the costs of running the foodbank and to purchase food. We rely on friends of South-West Belfast foodbank to help fundraise or give financially to keep the foodbank open to serve those in need.
